# Introduction

The PingFederate SiteMinder Integration Kit adds Identity Provider (IdP) and Service Provider (SP) Adapters to PingFederate. The SiteMinder IdP Adapter allows an IdP enterprise to extend an existing SiteMinder investment by using the SAML or WS-Federation protocols to expand the reach of the SiteMinder domain to partner applications. The SiteMinder SP Adapter allows an SP enterprise to accept SAML or WS-Federation assertions and provide Internet single sign-on (SSO) to SiteMinder-protected applications.

## Change List by Version

### SiteMinder Integration Kit 2.3.2 – September 2009

- Corrected inability to have multiple SiteMinder adapter instances deployed
- Added SiteMinder Policy Server response-header encoding

### SiteMinder Integration Kit 2.3 – October 2008

- Added support for realm protection level. If the user is not authorized for the realm protection level, the SiteMinder Adapter redirects to the Login URL for re-authentication.
- Modified implementation to correctly recognize a `null` or blank `Max Timeout SMSESSION` value on the Policy Server.
- Added support for setting `SMSESSION` token to the value `LOGGEDOFF` for SP-initiated Single Logout (SLO) instead of expiring the token.

### SiteMinder Integration Kit 2.2 – June 2008

- Corrected threading issue that occurred under high load
- Added support for `isPassive` and `ForceAuthn`

### SiteMinder Integration Kit 2.1 – March 2008

- Added support for handling `SMSESSION` tokens containing the value `LOGGEDOFF`
- Added support for `SMSESSION` token session-maximum and idle-timeout enforcement

### SiteMinder Integration Kit 2.0 – November 2007

- Multiple SiteMinder Policy Server support
- `SMSESSION` token prefix-naming to support SSO zones
- Authentication Context/Method passed from IdP adapter to SAML assertion
- Corrected SAML 2.0 `IsPassive` handling to return proper `Status Code`

## SiteMinder Integration Kit 1.0 – May 2006

- Initial Release

### Known Issues and Limitations

- If a modification is made to the SiteMinder Adapter configuration in PingFederate, the SiteMinder Agent is released and re-initialized on the subsequent SSO request. Any concurrent SSO requests will fail until the Agent is re-initialized with the new configuration.
- In PingFederate 5.1.0, SiteMinder SSO zones do not work because of a cookie-encoding issue. This feature works in all other versions of PingFederate, including 5.1.1.
