

Statement of Connector Qualification
The PingFederate Workday Connector 1.0
As of October 2009

Purpose:

This document describes known limitations and issues with the Workday Connector as well as officially tested (qualified) software versions, OS, and LDAP stores that interact with the kit. This is not a list of system requirements, but a list of what is known to work.

Prerequisites/Assumptions:

- JDK 1.5 or higher is required to run the PingFederate server and service WAR.
- An LDAP store is required to support direct login.

Known Issues:

- Adding a new certificate to PingFederate's trusted CA store for use in a secure LDAP (LDAPS) connection will not "take" without a server restart, if a secure LDAP connection has already been attempted or established.

Known Limitations:

- For all use-cases in the kit to work, you must use a SAML 2.0 connection with account mapping.

Software Versions Tested:

- pf-workday-connector-1.0
- SSO tested on:
 - PingFederate 6.0
 - PingFederate 6.1

Operating Systems Tested (Kit):

- Windows 2003 Server R2

Workday Configuration Tested:

- Workday 9, May 2009
- Workday Developer Sandbox environment with a single user enabled for Delegated Authentication

LDAP Directories Tested:

- Sun Java System Directory Server 5.2.4
- Active Directory 2003

Exclusions:

- The Workday Connector 1.0 is not FIPS 140 compliant.
- The Workday Connector 1.0 has not been tested with PingFederate using a Hardware Security Module (HSM).
- The Workday Connector 1.0 has not been tested on a system that supports 64-bit CPU
